Mandatory Competitions Baby to Little Miss Contestants

Beauty = 30% of Score

Baby Miss to Tiny Miss have the choice of a short or long formal gown. (Think Easter Sunday)

Little Miss and up are required to wear a long formal gown. This is a natural pageant so please keep hair and makeup age appropriate.

Theme Wear = 30% of Score

Our theme this year is "Carnival for a Cure"! Think the biggest showman, carnival performers and workers. Be creative! Check out our pintrest board for some great ideas. Please no midriffs shown in outfits.

Photogenic = 30% of Score

For this entry we are looking for a natural photo 5x7 or 8x10 it may be color or black and white. Photo should be submitted in a clear cover at time of registration on day of pageant. Natural and light retouching allowed. No Glitz photos please.

<u>Community Service</u> = 10% of Score

This pageant is being held as a fundraiser for Relay for Life. Contestants will receive 10% of their score by selling three luminaries for the Relay for Life of Onslow County. (It is MANDATORY for each contestant to sell three luminaries minimum)

Mandatory Competitions Junior to Mrs. Contestants

Beauty = 25% of Score

Little Miss and up are required to wear a long formal gown. This is a natural pageant so please keep hair and makeup age appropriate.

Theme Wear = 25% of Score

Our theme this year is "Carnival for a Cure"! Think the biggest showman, carnival performers and workers. Be creative! Check out our pintrest board for some great ideas. Please no midriffs shown in outfits.

Photogenic = 25% of Score

For this entry we are looking for a natural photo 5x7 or 8x10 it may be color or black and white. Photo should be submitted in a clear cover at time of registration on day of pageant. Natural and light retouching allowed. No Glitz photos please.

<u>Community Service = 10% of Score</u>

This pageant is being held as a fundraiser for Relay for Life. Contestants will receive 10% of their score by selling three luminaries for the Relay for Life of Onslow County. (It is MANDATORY for each contestant to sell three luminaries minimum)

On Stage Question = 15% of Score Contestant will be asked "Why do you Relay?" and be judged on her sincerity and the ability to express herself in a clear manner.

Awards and Titles

Miss Relay for Life of Onslow County Majestic Queen:

The Majestic Queen is the highest title for Teen Division and up that can be awarded in the pageant. A crown and sash will be awarded to the contestant who raises the most money for Relay for Life of Onslow County on our registered team.

Miss Relay for Life of Onslow County Mini Majestic Queen:

The Mini Majestic Queen is the highest title for Wee Miss to Junior Miss that can be awarded in the pageant. A crown and sash will be awarded to the contestant who raises the most money for Relay for Life of Onslow County on our registered team.

Miss Relay for Life of Onslow County Queen of Hope:

This is a crowned title that will be awarded to the contestant who sells the most Luminaries for Relay for Life. She will win a crown, sash, and Torch of Light at the event. All Luminary Order forms must be turned in by 9pm March 10, 2023.

Miss Relay for Life of Onslow County Sweetheart:

The Sweetheart title is a people choice award. Each vote is \$1.00. The contestant with the most votes will be awarded the Sweetheart Princess title. We will have bags with contestant's names and numbers on display at the pageant for people to drop their votes in. Contestants are allowed to collect votes before the day of the pageant. (All monies collected for votes will be donated to Onslow County Relay for Life) She will win a crown and sash. A Sweetheart queen will be crowned in both pageant segments.

Royal Miss Relay for Life:

The Royal title will be awarded to one of our wonderful Cancer Survivors participating in the pageant. This title will be awarded to the Survivor with the highest scores, ties to be broken by amount of money raised. She will win a crown and sash.

Age Division Winners:

Queens from each age division will win a crown and sash.

All Crowned Titles:

Queens are required to walk in the upcoming Relay for Life event, ride in the Jacksonville Holiday parade and will also be asked to return to next year's pageant to crown the next queen! Queens will also be asked to join in team fundraisers and events throughout the year. They will also be required to attend a mandatory photo shoot.

Queens Court:

1st and 2nd runner up in each age division will win a medal.

All Contestants:

Are asked to walk and support our team booth in the upcoming Relay for Life event April 22, 2023 at Northside High School.

All Contestants who raise \$100 or more will be in the ACS Hope Club and entered into a gift basket raffle.

All Contestants who raise \$1,000 or more will be recognized on stage with a special gift.

*We will not double crown! We will pull Majestic Titles, Queen of Hope, Sweetheart Queen, Royal, Princess first, then age division queens and court.

Important Notes:

- This is so much more than a pageant, we are a team brought together to advocate and to raise money for the American Cancer Society. This is a FUN fundraiser that I hope we all can enjoy together.
- Every single person who joins our team and participates in the pageant is asked to please attend the Relay for Life event April 22, 2023 at Northside High. It is very important for each of us to attend and show our support for our local Cancer Survivors and Caregivers.
- Our Team Party will be held in February we ask that everyone attend to help send out cards to cancer patients, get to know each other and get headshots done for the program book.
- It is important that all of our contestants register online under our team to make sure they get their t-shirt and be able to fundraise online.
